



“You can reach me
by railway...”

Birddog is based in Holborn, a short distance from Covent Garden and Leicester Square and with easy tube and bus connections from many major destinations in London. Please see below for directions to our offices.

Arriving on foot:

From outside Holborn tube station, cross the road (Kingsway) using the pedestrian crossing immediately on your right. Head left past Boots and walk 50 yards or so until reaching Parker Street (EAT is on the corner) on your right. Turn right here and Birddog is on your left, 25 yards down.

Walking from Leicester Square or Covent Garden, walk along Long Acre until you come to Drury Lane. Cross Drury Lane and begin walking along Great Queen Street. Take Newton Street on your left, and Parker Street is immediately on the right. On entering Parker Street, Birddog is on your right.

From London Waterloo rail station, head past the Southbank Centre across Waterloo Bridge. Once across the bridge, bear right along Aldwych. Take a left down Drury Lane until you reach Parker Street on your right. You've arrived!

Arriving by tube:

The nearest tube station to Birddog is Holborn, which is easily reached via the Central or Piccadilly Lines. Alternatively, Birddog is also within easy proximity of Covent Garden tube on the Piccadilly line.

Arriving by bus:

There are a number of bus services that stop on the Kingsway road in Holborn – seconds away from the Birddog offices.

- 1:** From New Oxford Street towards Canada Water Bus Station
- 8:** From Bow Church (Bow) towards Hollies Street (Oxford Circus)
- 59:** From Telford Road (Streatham Hill) towards Kings Cross St Pancras
- 68:** From Euston rail station towards Norwood High Street
- X68:** From West Croydon Bus Station towards Russell Square
- 91:** From Tottenham Lane (Hornsey) towards Whitehall/ Trafalgar Square
- 168:** From Royal Free Hospital (nr Hampstead) towards Dunton Road (Southwark)
- 171:** From Newquay Road (Lewisham) towards Holborn Station
- 188:** From North Greenwich Station (O2 Arena) towards Russell Square
- 243:** From Wood Green towards Waterloo Station
- 521:** From London Waterloo station towards London Bridge

Arriving by rail:

Birddog is best connected to major stations using the London Underground.

From London Bridge: Take the Northern Line northbound to Bank. Change here and take the Central Line westbound to Holborn.

From London Waterloo: Take the Northern Line northbound to Leicester Square. Change here and take the Piccadilly Line eastbound to Holborn.

From London Victoria: Take the Victoria Line northbound to Oxford Circus. Change here and take the Central Line eastbound to Holborn.

From King's Cross St Pancras: Simply take the Piccadilly Line westbound to Holborn.

From Paddington: Take the Bakerloo Line southbound to Oxford Circus. Change here and take the Central Line eastbound to Holborn.

From Euston: Take the Northern Line southbound to Tottenham Court Road. Change here and take the Central Line westbound to Holborn.

Arriving by air:

If you happen to be paying Birddog a flying visit, you can easily connect to our office from London's main airports.

Heathrow: The Heathrow Express (non-stop) runs every 15 minutes to Paddington station, while the Heathrow Connect (stopping service) runs every 30 minutes.

Alternatively, there is a London Underground service on the Piccadilly Line eastbound directly from Heathrow terminals to Holborn.

A National Express coach service is also available to London Victoria.

Gatwick: The Gatwick Express to London Victoria (non-stop) runs every 15 minutes. Other rail services connect Gatwick to London Bridge, London Victoria and St Pancras with regular trains every 15 minutes.

An EasyBus service from Gatwick to Earl's Court run every 15 minutes at peak times.

National Express coaches run to London Victoria from Gatwick every hour.

London City Airport: Take a Docklands Light Railway train to Bank. Here, change to the London Underground and take the Central Line westbound to Holborn.

Alternatively, a regular (but expensive) Shuttle Bus service runs to central London from the City Airport.
